Points may only be obtained by eligible teams in their own Region and are distributed according to each team's classification in the FEI Jumping Nations Cup ${ }^{\text {n }}$ Youth Competition according to the following scale

In case of a tie for any place on the overall Regional standings, teams are separated by:
 and so on until the tie is broken.
If after applying this method there is still a tie for any place at the conclusion of the last Event of the season, preference will be given to:

- the team with the greater number of clear rounds among the scores counting (i.e. maximum 3 scores per round per team) from each Competition throughout the season; if there is still a tie the scores counting (i.e. maximum 3 scores per round per team) for each team from each competition will be added together and preference will be given to the team with the lowest overall score
